Cancer Support Now Affiliates with Support Groups from People Living Through Cancer

As many of you know by now, People Living Through Cancer (PLTC) shut its doors on April 15. It had been around for 33 years, and leaves a void in the cancer support community. We will be doing our best to help continue their work.

3-5 Cancer Support Now has invited their support groups to affiliate with us. This would give them the benefit of the CSN Helpline for ongoing referrals into their groups.
